Colleen Denise Scott, 52, of 1249 Wren Dr. New Martinsville, WV, died at her home on Monday morning, April 23, 2007 with her husband at her side, following a courageous battle with cancer since March of 1999.

She was a graduate of River Local High School and Kent State University in 1977.
