Scott Cummins Harris, age 63 of Glen Easton, WV died Wednesday, September 25, 2024 at home, with family at his side.

He was born October 26, 1960 in Glen Dale, WV.

He was a 5th generation devoted farmer; a coal equipment operator for over 30 years with Kammer Power plant, AEP; a member of St. Francis Xavier Catholic Church; enjoyed card games, especially Euchre, 4-wheeling, and his 4-legged family; was a 4-H camp counselor for years; and he never met a stranger.
