March 30, 1934 - September 2, 2015

Cecil, Sonny, age 81, of Burnsville, WV, formerly of Proctor, WV, died Wednesday, September 2, 2015 at Ruby Memorial Hospital, Morgantown, WV. He was born March 30, 1934 in Proctor, the son of the late Edward and Bessie Woods Cecil.

Sonny retired from the U.S. Army after 25 years, serving multiple tours in Korea and Vietnam, and receiving two purple hearts.

He attended Proctor Christian Church as a child. He worked with the Paden City and Sistersville Ambulance service, and Iams Funeral Home Ambulance service. Sonny was a member of Morrison Lodge #76 F.&A.M. in Elizabethtown, KY, where he was a 32nd degree Mason; Kosair Shrine; and was an Honorable Kentucky Colonel.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by two sisters, his twin, Sally Sue Parks and Nelda Emch; three brothers, Glen, Sam and Edward "Bud" Cecil; and two nephews, Dale and Jim.

Survivors include two sisters, Edna Doty of New Martinsville, WV and Mary Lou Athey of Casper, WY; a brother, Buster Cecil of Proctor; a son, William C.
