Tallman, Terry T., MD, age 69, of Paducah Drive, New Martinsville, WV, died July 24, 2009 at Wetzel County Hospital, New Martinsville.

Dr. Tallman was born on November 3, 1939 in Centerville, Tyler County, West Virginia. He was the oldest son of the late Merrell H. Tallman and Wilma C. Hamilton Tallman.

He was a graduate of Tyler County High School and West Virginia University Medical School. He was a board certified member of the American Academy of Family Physicians.

He served his country as a Captain in the United States Air Force from 1963 until 1965 and was stationed in Alconbury, England.

He was engaged in the family practice of medicine at the Fairmont Clinic in Fairmont, West Virginia from 1966 until 1974 when he opened his medical practice in New Martinsville. He had a large family practice and delivered many babies at Wetzel County Hospital until he retired in 2005. He devoted his life to his family, patients, and the service of God. He faithfully served as a teacher, song leader and Elder at the Pine Street Church of Christ.

He is survived by his loving wife of 48 years, Glenda J. Mullett Tallman; his children, T. Jeanne Carboni and her husband, Rolf Carboni, Jill Haught and her husband, Timothy E. Haught, Dr. Todd Tallman and his wife Aimee Wetzel Tallman, Timothy Tallman and his wife Wendy Weber Tallman, and Matthew Tallman and his wife, Michelle O'Buck Tallman.
