January 25, 1927 - February 23, 2016

Theodore "Ted" Rist, age 89 of Hannibal, OH, died Tuesday, February 23, 2016 at his home.

He was born January 25, 1927 in Hannibal, the son of the late Francis Marion and Helen Chaplin Rist.

He was a retired River Boat Pilot for Standard Sand and Gravel, Wheeling, WV, a U.S. Navy WWII veteran, a member of the Duffy Church of Christ, the American Legion Post 760, Hannibal, VFW Post 9930, Duffy, OH and the Moose Lodge 931, New Martinsville, WV.

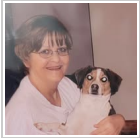
