Thomas A. Ferris, 92, of Moundsville, WV died Saturday, June 1, 2019 in Hubbard House Hospice, Charleston, WV.

He was born September 6, 1926 in Moundsville; the son of the late A. H. and Mary Zaid Ferris.

He was a US Army Veteran, serving in Korea; had a mechanical engineering degree from WVU; worked at Wheeling Steel, Wheeling Pittsburgh Steel, PPG, Ormet, Mobay, and retired from Bethany College.

He was a member of Our Lady of Lebanon Church in Wheeling; Earl Francis Post 3, American Legion; VFW 437; 40/8; a lifetime member of the Elks; and a served for over 20 years on the Moundsville Water Board.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Mary K. Ferris and twelve brothers and sisters.
