Thomas Jesse Mullett, 85, of Cincinnati, OH, formerly of Hilton Head Island, SC, passed away peacefully at home on January 7, 2018. Tom was born on December 5, 1932 in New Martinsville, West Virginia to the late Jesse B. and Mary (Atkinson) Mullett.

He graduated from Magnolia High School in 1950 where he participated in several sports. He then attended Potomac State. He served in the U.S. Army in Korea and attained the rank of Sergeant. After completing his military service he enrolled in the College of Engineering at West Virginia University where he earned a Bachelor's Degree in Industrial Engineering.
