



Thomas "Buck" Taylor Jr.

July 12, 1925 - March 3, 2015

Taylor, Thomas "Buck", Jr., age 89 of Moundsville, WV died Tuesday, March 3, 2015 in Wheeling Hospital Medical Park.

He was born July 12, 1925 in Coburn, WV, the son of the late Thomas Jefferson, Sr. and Beatrice Price Taylor.

He was a WWII Army Veteran; a retired field clerk from Columbia Gas; a member of Cameron First Christian Church, American Legion Post #18, Cameron, and he attended Moundsville First Christian Church.

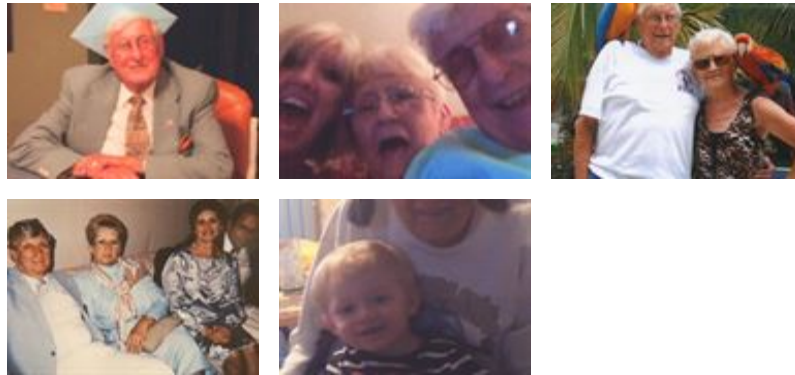
