Thomas Gene "T.J." Taylor, Jr., 45, of Clarington, OH passed away unexpectedly in Cambridge, OH while on the job.

Outside of work, T.J. found happiness and love in his girlfriend Kayla with whom he shared a special bond. His proudest achievements and work were being a loving and devoted father and Pappy to his two sons Dawson and

Trey and never missed an opportunity to be with his four grandchildren, Carter, Myles, Layla and Banks. An avid animal lover, TJ also loved his two dogs, Zeus and Stella, and cats, Jordy and Tigger.

In addition to the above, T.J. was a skilled hunter, shooter and marksman, and enjoyed golfing, having cookouts, watching Pirates baseball and being with his family and friends. 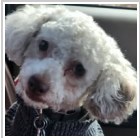
