Thomas M. Tisher, age 68 of Hannibal, OH passed away Saturday, December 24, 2022, at his residence.

He was born September 13, 1954, in New Martinsville, WV, son of the late Donald and Erma (Potts) Tisher.

Tom was a retired teacher with Switzerland of Ohio Schools and Magnolia High School.
