Tom E. Myles, age 88 of Wheeling, died Monday, March 14, 2016 at Ohio Valley Medical Center.

He was born July 17, 1927 in Wheeling, son of the late Thomas and Grace Neidhart Myles.

Tom was a retired rigger from Wheeling Pittsburgh Steel with 42 years of service with the last 14 years serving in Plant Protection.
