Tricia Lynn Leach, 43, of Etna, OH, was suddenly called home by her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on Thursday, January 26, 2017.

Mrs. Leach was born on April 10, 1973 in Wheeling, WV. She was the daughter of Phillip C. and Diana S. Rine of Rock Hill, SC.

She married Brooks Leach of Grafton, OH, on June 11, 1994. A graduate of Columbus State Community College, Mrs. Leach served as an executive assistant and notary public in legal, municipal, and church offices. Most recently, Mrs. Leach worked at the Columbus Brice location of the Andersons General Store.

Throughout her life, Mrs. Leach was a member of a number of local churches, including Dublin Baptist Church, New Life Gahanna, and Daybreak Church of Etna. Known by many for her caring personality and sweet disposition, Mrs. Leach enjoyed collecting Longaberger baskets, making memories and taking pictures, drinking specialty coffee with friends, and sharing life with her children.

Mrs. Leach is preceded in death by her mother, Diana S. Rine.

In addition to her father, Phillip C. 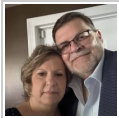

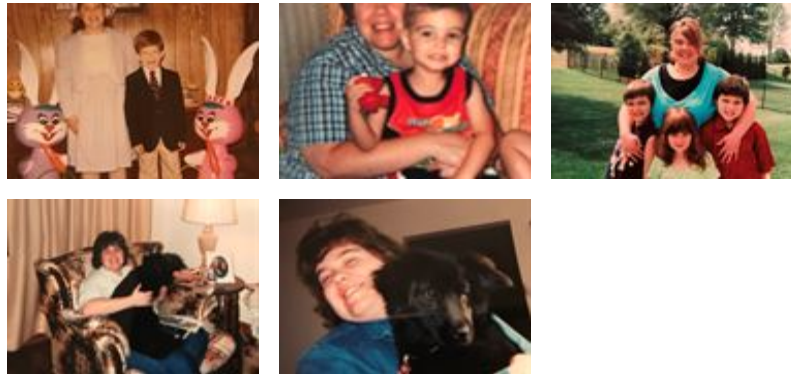
