Vernon A. "Pork" Kinneer, Sr., age 90 of Wheeling died Sunday, February 7, 2016 at Good Shepherd Nursing Home, Wheeling.

He was born June 10, 1925 in Marshall County, WV the son of the late Isaac and Rosa Earliwine Kinneer.

He was a retired carpenter at Ohio Valley Medical Center; a US Army veteran of WWII where he served with the 18 80th Aviation Engineers in Burma; a member of Our Lady of Peace Catholic Church and a former member of the Sherrard Volunteer Fire Department.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his wife, Betty Kinneer and four brothers, Elwood, Curtis, Calvin and Edwin Kinneer.
