Vickie Roberta Hess, 75, of Glen Dale, WV and formerly of Lumberport, WV returned peacefully to her heavenly home on September 4, 2015 after a brave battle with a lung disease. Her devotion to family and her deep faith in God carried her through her struggle.

Vickie was the daughter of the late Wayman R. and Dorothy P. Odell. She was born on September 9, 1939. She was a graduate of Lumberport High School and Alderson-Broaddus College with a Bachelors of Science degree in registered nursing. As a dedicated nurse for over 30 years, she devoted her life to caring for others. She spent more than 20 years at United Hospital Center in Clarksburg, WV, many of those spent in med-surg and psychiatric nursing. She took exceptional pride in her ability to care for patients compassionately, regardless of their condition.

Vickie was blessed with a loving family and supportive church home. She was an active member of Lumberport Baptist Church for her entire life and was also their former organist. She raised her three children in Christian love and was an incredible role model for her community. Her attitude of “always putting others first” was evident in her job as well as relationships with family and friends. Her ultimate act of selflessness is the donation of her body to the Human Gift Registry at WVU Hospital.

Vickie is survived by her son, Mark (Lisa) Hess of Charlotte, NC; her daughter Lori (Paul) Knotts of Spelter, WV; her son David (Michelle) Hess of Glen Dale, WV; and five grandchildren, Ashley and Jeremy Hess, Kristen Knotts, Sydney and Sarah Hess.
