December 4, 1916 - September 17, 2015

Amos, Virginia M., 98, of Route 7, New Martinsville, WV, died Thursday, September 17, 2015 at Genesis Health Care Center, New Martinsville. She was born December 4, 1916 in West, WV, the daughter of the late Charles F. and Edna Sivert Herman.

Virginia was a sales clerk for 15 years at Ruttenberg's and a member of the Steelton Church of Christ. She was a wartime worker in Delaware at Triumph Explosives, a division of Hercules Powder Company, making 40mm anti-aircraft ammunition, and also for Glen L. Martin (Lockheed) making fighter aircraft.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Everett L. Amos in 1988; three brothers, Willard, Dale and Ray Herman; and four sisters, Martha Goddard, Faye Hunter, Leota "Lee" Baker, and Ruby Sylvester.

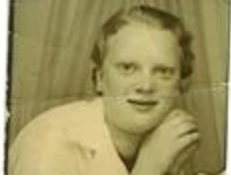
