



## Walter Robert (Bob) Myers

January 1, 1924 - May 24, 2017

Walter Robert (Bob) Myers, 93, of New Martinsville died Wednesday, May 24, 2017 at Wetzel County Hospital after a brief illness. He was a retired foreman of the Print Shop at the Federal Trade Commission in Washington, DC., a former Deacon of the First Christian Church in New Martinsville, and an Army Staff Sergeant in the OSS during World War II. He was preceded in death by his parents, Walter Michael Myers and Claudia L. Sole Myers; one brother, George Myron Myers and one sister, Nell Myers Hanlon.
