William Warren Wellman, age 96 of Moundsville, WV died Wednesday, May 30, 2018 in Reynolds Memorial Hospital, Glen Dale, WV.

He was born June 11, 1921 in Marshall County, WV, the son of the late William Earl and Belva Ray Wellman.

He was a WWII Army Air Corps Staff Sergeant having been involved in the following campaigns; Normandy, Northern France, Rhineland, Central Europe, Liberation of Paris, and Battle of the Bulge; a life-member of VFW Post #437; and was an avid golfer.
