Wise, Charles "Tom", age 83 of Moundsville, died, Sunday May 19, 2013 at Reynolds Memorial Hospital, Glen Dale.

He was born April 22, 1930 in Moundsville, son of the late Daniel and Olive Fisher Wise.

Tom was retired from Allied Chemical, a US Army veteran of the Korean War, member of St. Francis Xavier Catholic Church, Moundsville, served on the School Board at Bishop Donahue High School where he was active with the Athletic Boosters.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his wife: A. Louise Wise and three brothers: Glen, Dean and K. Wise.
