He served as Wetzel County Commissioner for 6 years, was on Wetzel County Hospital Board of Directors, on Public Defenders Committee, he was Treasurer for Grandview/Doolin Water Board, was past President for New Martinsville Senior Citizens and served as Treasurer for New Martinsville Senior Citizens. He was a member of Masonic Lodge #39, Nemesis Shriners of Parkersburg, Grand Chapter Sistersville #27, Tri-County Shrine Club, Ohio Valley Shrine Club, Loyal Order of the Moose in New Martinsville, The National Association of Postmasters, he was a Senior Counselor for Mountaineer Boys State for 25 years and worked with the Band Patrons at Magnolia High School for 8 years. He worked with Legion Baseball

for 8 years at Marne Post #28 of New Martinsville. His family had hosted 9 exchange students in their home. He enjoyed his gardening, raising his chickens, being in the woods looking for ginseng and yellow root. His most favorite pastime was spending his time with his children and grandchildren. His family was his pride and joy.
