Yost, Evang. Jerry, age 70, of Hannibal, Ohio, died Monday, March 11, 2013 at Marietta Memorial Hospital, Marietta, OH.

He was born November 28, 1942 in Farmington, WV, the son of the late Denzil and Bethel Cole Yost.

Jerry was a minister at the Church of Christ in Duffy, Ohio for 38 years and was actively involved in the family business Sounds Incredible. He also was a director and loved working for the WV Christian Youth Camp for over 40 years.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a brother, Jim Yost; a step father, Earl Lough; a step sister, Loretta Rowand; and an infant nephew, James Andrew Yost .
